#### • Orchestra Scholarship Program:

- Dana confirmed 2 parents attended the kick off meeting and are excited to participate as part of the scholarship committee.
- Board agreed that we will keep the process completely virtual/digital for this school year, leveraging on Google Drive
- Mr Sharplin will create a Google form for the kids to submit their applications and videos.
- First announcement/reminder to student will be sent out in January 2021
- In Mid-March a Formal announcement of the scholarship will be send from the Booster club to all Seniors.
- There will be 3 scholarships granted by ROBC, one for the Total amount of \$1,000 and 2 more of \$500 each.
- <u>School year update</u>: Mr. Elizondo updated the board with the existing plan with the following key points:
  - Mrs Sorgi Lopes Middle School Orchestra Director has asked Mr. Elizondo to represent Reagan in a special concert for 6th graders at Lopez.
  - Mr. Elizondo shared his experience @ the Orchestra Virtual concert.
    - technical difficulties in future will rehearse prior with the technology used.
    - virtual production difficult to do due to lack of resources from tech department all departments asking for their services
    - There may be one more concert in the spring done as a combination with the choir to leverage resources.
  - UIL contest Will be sending out invites to compete, Solo and ensemble
    - Judges to come to Reagan directly instead of the kids traveling.
      - Contest will be in late February.
      - There will be a need to collect \$8 from all students wanting to participate in the State Auditions.
      - Mr. Elizondo to send Nate a summary of the ask.
      - Nate to create a paypal link for this collection of payment.
      - Orchestra is requesting the Booster club to support with \$400 of funding.
      - This was agreed upon in the meeting.
  - There will be a spring musical (Bright Star), strings only.
    - There will be an audition due to the lack of seats they will have for the orchestra.
      - Only Chamber orchestra can audition due to limited space.
