**Spring Concert General Meeting Minutes**

Mr. Elizondo welcomed everyone to the end of year, Spring Concert, at 7:00 pm. He mentioned that we have an end of year program for everyone that includes copies of each of the concert programs from this year, group photographs of each orchestra, as well as ads. We hope that you are impressed with the program and consider buying an ad next year. The ads help us to cover the cost of the program. It is like an Orchestra Yearbook.

We are starting the program tonight with our Harp Ensemble. It is a preview of a Harp Concert later this week on Wednesday at 5:30 pm in the Orchestra Room.

Melissa Jozwiak, ROBC President, addressed attendees noting we had record sales tonight for the pre-concert dinner and hope everyone enjoyed the meal and also participated in our silent auction. She also announced that our Reagan Chamber Orchestra was invited to attend the Midwest Orchestra Festival in December and we will need to help with fundraising to support this event. We have a letter included at the back of the program to help with obtaining corporate and community sponsors.

Melissa also advised attendees that we have two board positions that need to be filled for next year, President and Treasurer. She opened the floor for nominations. She confirmed we have at least one nomination for each of these positions. No floor nominations were received. In the coming weeks, we will send an email to vote on these two positions as well as next year's ROBC budget.

The concert began with the 3, 4, 5 and 7<sup>th</sup> period combined sub-varsity orchestra performance.

During the Orchestra transition, Mr. Elizondo noted that uniform collection will be in the cafeteria immediately following the concert tonight. We have 8 volunteers with iPads in the cafeteria helping to collect these uniforms. This will be the only opportunity to collect uniforms.

The Sinfonia Orchestra performed next. They were followed by the Chamber Orchestra performance.

The last two years we have had so many seniors graduating (35-45 each year) that Mr. Elizondo decided to have a Senior Orchestra. The senior students voted on the piece they were going to play tonight as a Senior Orchestra. Mr. Elizondo then presented each senior a single white rose and thanked them for all they have done for our program and wished them the best of luck next year.

At this time, the winds and brass joined the stage to perform with the full Symphony Orchestra.

During the final Orchestra transition, Melissa thanked everyone that volunteered to chaperone this past year. She also thanked Elsa and Denise for organizing a wonderful dinner tonight as well as all of those that are volunteering to help with uniform collection after the concert. The final two selections were performed by all orchestras on stage at once. The concert concluded at 8:48 pm.
