



**Reagan Orchestra Booster Club
General Meeting Minutes

Mr. Elizondo welcomed everyone to the final Reagan Orchestra concert of the year and final ROBC General Meeting to be held during the breaks between performances. Mr. Elizondo introduced Melissa Jozwiak, ROBC President. President's Address:

By majority vote, the ROBC welcomes Mr. Swoyer and Mrs. Terhesh to the Executive Board for 2018-2019.

Treasurer's Address:

During the next break between performances, Mark Rowe, ROBC Treasurer, presented the proposed budget for the following year, confirming that a copy of the budget was posted on the website and at the entrance to the auditorium for review. The budget for next year is flat over this past year with no change in fees and keeps fundraising consistent. The budget will plan for breakeven year. Mark opened the floor up for questions and discussion. As there were no questions, a motion was made and seconded to pass and accept the budget with no changes.

Vice President's Address:

During the next break between performances, Jim Schuppenhauer, ROBC Vice President, addressed the group to thank them for participating in our Silent Auction fundraising event and further bidding opportunities would be available after the concert.

Each orchestra student of the graduating class of 2018 was presented with a single rose by Mr. Elizondo and Mr. Sharplin before performing one final piece as a senior class orchestra. Congratulations and best wishes to our graduating students!
