- General Status this year: We are on the right track of having similar numbers from last year.
 - Mr. Elizondo commented there are some All State and Region fees expected to be paid in the next month. \$160 aprox. for AllState participants and \$380 aprox. for Philharmonic Region participants.
 - o Kristen mentioned, there are an additional 14 Washtub cards to be purchased, picked up and delivered.
 - o Kristen confirmed a check for \$200 was received from the Jets Pizza fundraising event
 - o So far we have received \$38 from the fuzzy socks fundraising.
 - There is a \$25 cash to purchase a polo shirt that was not attached to a form, to be determined who
 does it belong too.

• Fund Raising:

- Kristen had contacted the following;
 - Jets's Pizza completed in October, revenue of \$200 payment was received
 - Torchy's scheduled for Tuesday, November 17th from 4-8pm

 Kristen to work with Tara on marketing.
 - MOD pizza to be scheduled for December;
- o Jets Pizza fundraising was a big success, had a great participation.
- o Kristen suggested we could use Balloons, Music and Banners @ the Torchy's event.
- o Kristen/Tara to work on the flyer to advertise the Torchy's event.
- o Mr. Elizondo will provide the Reagan Orchestra banner to use at the Torchy's event.
- o Fuzzy's socks fundraising still going, will be again advertised –Tara will market on Facebook, Charms, Email Blast.
- Kristen suggested to send out a Thank you Note using a previous Reagan Orchestra Thank you template.
- Mr Elizondo agreed to make a Thank you Note to the Jets Pizza manager on behalf of the Reagan Orchestra program. Kristen to deliver it in person.

• Orchestra Scholarship Program:

- The orchestra scholarship program is going to be based of the Reagan choir scholarship program.
- o Applications are going to be submitted by video through Flipgrid app.
- Requirements for the application are still going to be determined by the directors and committee.
- O Committee should be form by 4 judges, and email is going to be sent out to ask parents if they want to volunteer and be part of it.
- o Judges can't be parents of seniors students in the actual 20-21 school year.
- o Last date of application submission will be April 2nd 2021
- Gabriela shared her experience as a judge for the Choir Scholarship Program and mentioned the judges had about a week to make a decision about who was getting the scholarship.
- O Gabriela also mentioned the Choir Scholarship was granted to 3 different students, one for \$1,000 and two for \$500 each, suggested this could be implemented at the Orchestra scholarship too, so more than one person is impacted by it.

Marketing:

- O Tara used the Orchestra Facebook page, charms email and Reagan email blast, to advertise the Jets Pizza fundraising event and was very effective.
- Tara would send the email to Mr Elizondo to send to administration for them to promote as well.
- O Daniella suggested we should advertised also in the Reagan Parents Facebook Page, will share future posts.

- Tara will check Facebook page traffic to find the best time to post.
- <u>School year update</u>: Mr. Elizondo updated the board with the existing plan with the following key points:
 - o School year so far is going very well. Hybrid classes are working fine and kids are working hard.
 - o Spirit Shirts were hand out and kids are using them to promote the Reagan Orchestra Program.
 - o TMEA rehearsal already started in person.
 - o Planning on a virtual concert for the month of December. Probably will consist in 3 different videos.
 - Nate suggested ROBC could help with founds to have an editing company work on the edition of the videos.
 - o Tara mentioned she could help find an editing company that would help Mr. Elizondo and Mr. Sharplin with the editing of the orchestra concert videos.
